







































Post excavation analysis of the Burial Field 071:009 will be conducted through the winter and spring of 2017-2018. A final report is expected in late spring of 2018. A major part of that work will include the conservation and analysis of the artefactual material, and will be carried out in co-operation with Þjóðminjasafn Íslands. Over 1000 iron and other artefacts were recovered, the great majority of these being nails and/or clenched bolts and /or roves. Other tasks include the detailed analysis of wood remains, the study of human osteological material, the study of the archaeo-faunal material, the development of a structural and stratigraphic narrative and, not least, a preliminary assessment of the importance of the discovery in a broader national and international context.
